Job Title: Sunday Morning Clergy

Job Description: The Sunday morning priest is responsible for presiding, reading the Gospel, distributing communion, and participating in the life of the parish on a part-time basis.

Responsibilities include:

- Preside at one or both morning services
- When not presiding, read the Gospel, distribute communion, do the dismissal
- Meet and greet parishioners in the narthex before, between, and after the services
- Attend monthly liturgy meetings
- Attend special services (Holy Week, Christmas, etc.)
- Attend liturgical rehearsals as assigned
- Preside and preach at some funerals and weddings as assigned
- Attend Parish wide events as a way of developing relationships with parishioners
- Provide pastoral care including visiting parishioners at their home or in the hospital
- Conduct Retirement Community Eucharists as assigned or as schedule permits

Requirements include:

- Ordination as an Episcopal Priest
- A passion for helping others grow along their spiritual journey
- Collaborative, detail-oriented, and highly motivated
- Willingness to be flexible, and adapt to Epiphany's liturgical style and well-developed incorporation of lay ministers

Part-time salaried, exempt 10 hours per week
